

2021 INTERSTATE SHOWDOWN SERIES

Updated 8-3-2021

1. Eligibility –

For 2021, there is no fee required to participate in the series. All exhibitors are eligible.

2. Participating Shows – for 2021, all shows must use Showman.app for entries.

- May 14-16, 2021 WV Boer Goat Blitz, Clearbrook, VA
- July 2-4, 2021 Firecracker Classic, Clearbrook, VA
- July 16-18, 2021 Summer Jam, Harrisonburg, VA
- September 25-26, 2021 State Fair of Virginia, Doswell, VA
- October 8-10, 2021 Southeastern Premier Classic, Cookeville, TN
- October 15-17, 2021 Country Roads Classic, Lewisburg, WV
- October 22-24, 2021 Apple Country Classic, Clearbrook, VA

3. Entries

- A. There is no limit on the number of animals included in the series.
- B. Points will be given to the exhibitor entering the animal in the show.
- C. If exhibitors switch during the year, animal points will follow exhibitor.
- D. Market entries and commercial animals
 - I. Must use the complete official scrapie tag at all shows, not a herd tag. Tattoos and microchips are acceptable scrapie ID.
 - II. Only youth exhibitors under 21 as of January 1, 2021 are eligible for points in series

4. Showmanship

- A. Points will be separated into JABGA, Market Goat, and Market Lamb Showmanship.
- B. Divisions are separated by age as of January 1, 2021 as follows:
 - I. JABGA- Senior (14-18), Intermediate (9-13), Junior (4-8)
 - II. Market Lamb and Market Goat Showmanship
Senior (16-21), Intermediate (12-15), Junior (8-11), PeeWee (7 and under)
- C. PeeWee Showmanship may have a helper to lead the goat only. The helper is not allowed to position the goat.
- D. Market exhibitors will be given showmanship points based on the classes they compete in at the show since age breaks may be different.

5. Points at shows

- A. Top 5 must be placed for each class.
- B. Points will be assigned according to the number in the class.
1st – 5 x number entries, 2nd – 4 x number entries, 3rd – 3 x number entries, 4th – 2 x number entries, 5th – 1 x number entries.
- C. Disqualified goats will not receive any points but will still count as an entry in the class.
- D. All remaining goats not placing in top five will receive 2 points.
- E. Bred and Owned will be counted as a class placing toward JABGA animal points.

- F. Champion and Reserve points will be awarded for animals only, not showmanship.
 - I. Division Champion - 10 points
 - II. Division Reserve – 5 points
 - III. Overall Champion – 30 points
 - IV. Overall Reserve –20 points

6. End of Year Awards

- A. Animal Points will be taken from the **three (3)** highest ranking animals at the end of the season from all animals exhibited for each division for exhibitor of the year.
- B. ABGA Exhibitor of the Year – One for each – Percentage Doe, Fullblood Doe, and Buck
- C. JABGA Exhibitor of the Year
 - I. One for each – Percentage Doe, Fullblood Doe, Buck
 - II. Showmanship points will be added to total animal points.
- D. Market Goat Exhibitor of the Year
 - I. Market Goats, Wether Does and Commercial Doe classes will be eligible.
 - II. Showmanship points will be added to total animal points.
- E. Market Lamb Exhibitor of the Year
 - I. Market Goats, Wether Does and Commercial Doe classes will be eligible.
 - II. Showmanship points will be added to total animal points.
- F. High Point Animal
 - I. ABGA – 1 award for Percentage, Fullblood Doe, and Buck combined
 - II. JABGA – 1 award for Percentage, Fullblood Doe, and Buck combined
 - III. JABGA Showmanship – per age group
 - IV. Market Goat
 - V. Wether Doe – Commercial Doe included
 - VI. Market Showmanship Goat – per age group
 - VII. Market Lamb
 - VIII. Wether Dam – Commercial Ewe included
 - IX. Market Showmanship Lamb – per age group
 - X. Combination Showmanship – Goat and Lamb – per age group

Adjustments may be needed throughout the season and are at the discretion of the show hosts for all participating shows.
